

RESPECT

West Lafayette, Indiana (where the ABA office is located) is about an hour from Indianapolis; therefore most of our news comes out of Indy. As I'm sure you know Indianapolis is also the home of the Super Bowl winning Colts. The Colts are an outstanding sport team. They say a prayer before each game (something that's relatively unheard of in this day and age). They also say a prayer of thanksgiving after each win. After the Super Bowl win, the owner James Irsay, coach Tony Dungy and quarterback Peyton Manning all thanked God first for getting them where they are. Coach Dungy never raises his voice, not at practice and not during the game. He never swears. The team is always dressed appropriately and stays out of trouble. Many of the team members also do volunteer work and have their own charities. The Colts franchise took all employees, including cooks, grounds keepers and janitors to Miami for the Super Bowl. They know it takes everyone to be a winning team.

On the flip side of that, Indianapolis is also home of the Pacers (the professional basketball team, for those of you who may not keep up with basketball). I couldn't even tell you how their season is going. All we hear about on the news out of the Pacers is who's been arrested for starting fights or carrying weapons. Both players and the coach get ejected from games for unsportsmanlike conduct — yelling at refs, kicking chairs, fighting with fans, etc.

I don't know of many farms that are making millions of dollars a year so the spotlight may not be on them as much as a famous sports star. But, if the news came to do a story on your family and farm, what would the story be like — the Colts, the Pacers or somewhere in between? Does your family work together to make the best hogs it can (Colts) or is everyone out for themselves (Pacers)? When you get to a show, do you loose gracefully and win even more gracefully (Colts) or make a public spectacle of yourself (Pacers)? Do you help others out and be friendly (Colts) or do you stick to yourself and why would you ever want to help someone else do well (Pacers)? Do you stay calm around your pig (Colts) or do you yell and shove your pig to get it to do what you want (Pacers)?

Parents, ag teachers 4-H leaders and FFA advisors, what about you? How do you act around others and at shows? Are you setting a good example? Are you teaching our kids to be the next leaders? I know you aren't signing contracts for millions of dollars a year, but many kids look up to you just as much, if not more, than they do a famous sports star. They want to be like you. Being an ag teacher or 4-H leader when they grow up is an achievable goal, unlike becoming famous (as very few do).

I think it all comes back to one word — RESPECT. Are we teaching our youth to be respectful? Do they respect themselves and others? Do they show respect for the pig they are showing, the judge that doesn't place them where they think they should be placed and the ring crew who helps pen their pig in the pen they don't want to be in? Do they show respect for the show coordinators when they check in their pigs?

Being prepared helps us to be respectful, because you won't have as many things go wrong. Have your parking pass and tickets ready when you get to the fair gate. Make sure your registration papers match the pig that you are taking to the show. Make sure your health papers meet the regulations that are printed. If any of these things are incorrect, it can cause you to be disrespectful as you try to push the blame to someone else when really it is your own fault. We all make mistakes with paperwork, but not checking the paperwork to make sure it's correct is the biggest mistake of all.

This spring, as you sell showpigs in the Midwest, show respect to your buyers and get the papers transferred in a timely fashion. Don't make them call you over and over again to get papers.

Take time as a family to review how you respect others. Are you where you want to be? Can you do a better job? We can all be Super Bowl winners if we show others the respect they deserve.

Good luck to everyone this summer as they show. Travel safely. "Show a little RESPECT."

General Entry Requirements

- All purebred gilt and barrow exhibitors will pay an entry fee of \$25 per head that will be listed on the individual entry form. All crossbred gilt and barrow exhibitors will pay an entry fee of \$35 per head that will be listed on the individual entry form. Late $\,$ entries will be \$50 per head.
- Two head per sex per breed will be allowed to enter per exhibitor
- 3. In order to show a crossbred barrow or gilt, the exhibitor must also show (not just enter) a purebred barrow.
- All participants who do not show a gilt or barrow at this event will need to pay a participation fee of \$5 if they wish to exhibit in showmanship and/or the judging contest.
- All hogs must be identified with a permanent ear notch. All crossbred barrows and gilts must have an ear tag and be identified on the health papers with the ear notch and tag
- Powdering, oiling or any dressing applied to hogs other than water will not be allowed. Exhibitors may be asked to take their animals to the wash racks by the show officials to remove this dressing. Show officials reserve the right to disqualify any animal from competition not meeting this requirement. Whole body clipping of market hogs is discouraged.
- 7. Absolutely no clipping of hogs will be allowed on the show
- 8. NJSA and Team Purebred reserve the right to randomly test for the presence of unapproved drugs in swine entries.
- 9. Entries are due April 27. Late entries will be accepted as space
- 10. No entries accepted at the show.
- 11. Entry fees are non-refundable
- 12. NSR, CPS, ABA, NSPA, NJSA and Team Purebred are not liable for accidents.
- 13. All WPX Junior National entries and checks (purebred and crossbred) must be mailed to NSR. Attention: Director of Junior Activities, P.O. Box 2417, West Lafayette, IN 47996-2417.

Exhibitor Requirements

- 1. All purebred hog exhibitors must be members of their respective junior associations -- National Junior Swine Association or Team
- 2. Exhibitors must be 21 years of age or younger as of Jan. 1,
- 3. Exhibitors must wear their exhibitor numbers given to them at registration during the gilt show and showmanship contest.
- If exhibitor is not present to show the animal, the animal cannot be exhibited unless previously approved by show officials.

Arrival/Dismissal

- Participants must pen their entries in the designated area, even if they are entered in the open show.
- No moving or switching of pen cards at the show. If special penning is required, these requests must be submitted in advance and approved by show officials. This system will allow us to find participants more quickly if problems arise.

 3. All pigs will be released on Fri., June 8, after the sweepstakes
- Swine entries may not be released until the designated release time. If any swine leave the show early, the exhibitor and their family will not be allowed to compete in NJSA or Team Purebred activities for one year.

Additional Gilt Show Information

- Breed classes will be broken according to farrowing dates, with class size as equal as possible.
- 2. Purebred gilts shown in the WPX Junior National are eligible to be exhibited in the open show and sold as long as they are double-entered in the name of the junior exhibitor. Crossbred Gilt Requirements

Market Animal Requirements (Purebred and Crossbred Barrows)

- Purebred barrow entries must be registered Berkshire, Chester White, Duroc, Hampshire, Landrace, Poland China, Spotted or Yorkshire barrows born Nov. 1, 2006, and after.
- All barrows (purebred and crossbred) must weigh between 220 and 280 pounds.
- 3. Entries $\overset{\centerdot}{\text{may}}$ be purchased barrows, but must be owned by the junior exhibitor, the exhibitor's family name, or exhibitor's farm name by April 27, 2007.
- Purebred barrows must be registered in the junior exhibitor's name, exhibitor's family name, or exhibitor's farm name.

- This is not a terminal show. Exhibitors will be responsible for their own barrows
- 10. If an exhibitor wishes to sell their market hog to a packer following the show, they must sign up at check-in.

Duroc, Hampshire, Landrace & Yorkshire Entries:

- All animals are to be guaranteed negative of the stress gene to be exhibited at a NSR or NJSA event.
- NSR and NJSA reserve the right to randomly collect a DNA profile on exhibited animals for parentage verification at any event where registered animals are exhibited. This collection will be supervised by NSR or NJSA representatives.
- All breed champions, reserve champions and/or any randomly selected gilts may be blood tested for presence of the stress gene, parentage verification, and breed purity as DNA technology becomes available.
- The overall champion and reserve champion barrow and/or any randomly selected barrows may be blood tested for presence of the stress gene, parentage verification, and breed purity as DNA technology becomes available.
- Champion and reserve champion overall premiums as well as breed champion and reserve champion premiums will not be awarded until the DNA results are verified at the NSR office.
- Any gilts that fail these DNA tests for the stress gene, parentage verification or breed purity will be asked to forfeit all gilt show premiums and awards. Showmanship standings, how not be affected by failed test results.
- Failed test results will not be publicized except in the normal listing of cancelled pedigrees that is published in the NSR newsletter, For the Record, and in the NJSA newsletter, The Pinnacle.



Editorial

Remember How You Got Here!

The past several months have been especially difficult to many of us with unseasonably cold chilling temperatures, unbelievable ice storms and blizzards, and disastrous farrowing house fires. But worse than these are some deaths to our swine families. It is never easy to deal with any of these circumstances, but we must venture forward.

My hectic schedule travelling to meetings and events in January and February has given me a lot of time to think about the future, but I always thought, "How did we get to this point?" The generation or generations before us have laid the groundwork for us to move forward. They've given us the opportunity to work with genetics that they have carefully assembled. They've allowed breed registries to be solvent, business oriented, and honest in their dealings regardless of the size or location of their operation.

It is important that we ask these people that are breed stalwarts some very important questions while we still have a chance. Questions such as - what are the major strengths and weaknesses of our breed? When hogs got too tall and too narrow, why did we go so far, and how do we know when we have gone too far? How did you know when you raised or bought Mr. Great Boar, that he would be the next Super Sire? When Breed Associations would dictate policy to breeders that you thought was wrong, what approach did you take to make Board members or staff aware that these were harming policies?

The road may that we have been given by past seedstock producers was pretty well marked. Straying from the main route may not be the route you want to choose. We will be farther ahead if we tap the minds of our forefathers, past leaders and educators before it is too late.

Being a cocky 22 year-old out of college, it didn't take me long to figure out that their are two sides to every pancake. No matter how thin you make that pancake, there is still another side. We don't have all the answers all of the time, and if we do have the

answers, everyone of them may not be right. 

Animals originating from the herds outside the state of Indiana MUST use this permit number - A04-2407.

Certificates Must Show:

- 1. Pigs must come from either a qualified negative PRV herd or tested negative for pseudorabies within the last 30 days. Herd Validation number must appear on health certificate and date of last quarterly test (within 90 days). Pigs must also originate from brucellosis free herd or tested negative for brucellosis within 30 days. In addition, the following statement must appear on health certificate: **Hogs have not been fed raw garbage.**
- 2. Remember, all pigs must have two copies of individual health papers.
- 3. All crossbred hogs must be identified on Health paper by tag number, not ear notch, as all crossbreds must be tagged, with tags gotten from state veterinarians. This is a Federal law.
